RESOLUTION FOR ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS

Grundy County Resolution No. 11-2012/2013

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of the Iowa Code Sections 321.255 and 321.285 of the Code of Iowa, to determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, that the speed limit of any secondary road is greater than is reasonable and proper under the conditions existing, and may determine and declare a reasonable and proper speed limit, and

WHEREAS, such an investigation has been requested and has been completed by the Grundy County Engineer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF GRUNDY COUNTY that the speed limit be established and appropriate signs be erected at the location described as follows:

COUNTY ROAD D-19 WESTBOUND TRAFFIC:

County Road D-19 (formerly State Highway 20), begin 40MPH approximately 1,283 ft. west of V Ave and D-19 intersection (SW Cor. Sec. 34, T89N, R15W) westerly to approximately 1,043 ft. west of T-55 So. and D-19 intersection (NW Cor. Sec. 5, T88N, R15W) and thence begin 55MPH; AND

COUNTY ROAD D-19 EASTBOUND TRAFFIC:

County Road D-19 (formerly State Highway 20), begin 40MPH approximately 1,043 ft. west of T-55 So. and D-19 intersection (NW Cor. Sec. 5, T88N, R15W) easterly to approximately 1,283 ft. west of V Ave and D-19 intersection (SW Cor. Sec. 34, T89N, R15W) and thence begin 55MPH.
