WHEREAS, Grundy County, Iowa is a Participating Local Government that receives a Direct Distribution Amount under the Opioid Settlement Agreements, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Grundy County, Iowa, has been approached with the following proposals regarding the expenditure of the LG Abatement Fund, and


WHEREAS, the Board believes it to be in the best interests of the citizens of Grundy County and is supportive of the general welfare of its citizens to utilize the LG Abatement Funds to support education and prevention of opioid abuse in the County, and

WHEREAS, Grundy County Emergency Management has requested up to \$4,000.00 for opioid abuse and overdose training, and

WHEREAS, Grundy County Public Health has requested up to \$10,000.00 for opioid abuse and prevention materials and funds to provide this education to the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Grundy County Board of Supervisors, that the Auditor is hereby authorized to make such transfers from the LG Abatement Fund to the Grundy County Emergency Management Fund and Grundy County Public Health Fund in the amounts as are necessary so long as the total transferred amount does not exceed the maximum amount for each project as stated hereinabove.
